Requirements.

1. Complete **at least 7 required honors courses** (min. 23 units, including 2 honors 1-unit seminars) as outlined below with the **minimum 3.3 cumulative GPA**.
2. Complete all honors courses with a grade of B or better (**B- is not acceptable**).

Complete a minimum of five courses from Section I. Note: A maximum of two courses may be completed for Honors Scholar credit from section IB (*Approved Alternate Courses*).

UCLA TRANSFER ADMISSION PROGRAM (TAP)
Requirements

To participate in the UCLA TAP program, students must complete all of the Honors Scholar requirements. **IMPORTANT NOTE: Students are required to complete at least 12 units in honors courses by the end of the fall quarter preceding their transfer for UCLA TAP Certification eligibility.** TAP applicants must be regular participants in the Foothill Honors Institute. UCLA TAP applicants should see a Foothill counselor for appropriate course planning.
