Common Questions

About College from Undocumented Students



Can I go to college if I am undocumented?

Yes. There are no federal or state laws that prohibit undocumented students from attending Foothill College.



Will I qualify for financial aid as an undocumented student?

Yes. Foothill College offers financial aid and scholarship opportunities for **all** students.



Will I have to pay high tuition costs because I am undocumented?

No. Undocumented students who have a diploma (or GED) and have studied in California for 3 years qualify for in-state tuition rates per California Assembly Bill 540.



If I apply for college or financial aid, can the government learn about my immigration status?

No. Foothill College will not share information with immigration enforcement unless required by judicial order. We are committed to protecting our students.



Are there student services I cannot access because I am undocumented?

No. Every student at Foothill can access our free services and support, regardless of status.



Will I be the only undocumented student?

No. Foothill College proudly serves many undocumented students each year.
