- Diagnostic Medical Sonography had no graduates in 2020-21 so there were no licensure pass rates available that year. The college is currently working to fill a full-time position (as faculty program director) to replace the retired faculty. The program will come off hiatus and enroll a new cohort in the 2022-23 academic year.
- Job placement data obtained using the California Core Indicator Report (2021-22), where the most recent report is based on FY15/16, FY16/17, FY17/18 employment numbers.
- Institution-Set Standards based on 75% of 3-year average count/rate.
- Stretch goals based on a 10% increase from most recent count/rate. Note that stretch goals for CTE Employment Rates are identified based on a 1-percentage point increase above the 3-year average rate.
