## FOOTHILL COLLEGE CSU GENERAL EDUCATION/BREADTH REQUIREMENT 2020-2021 Academic Year

Foothill College will certify completion of 58 quarter units of the 70-unit General Education requirement for graduation from the CSU for students satisfying courses from the following pattern. The remaining 12 quarter units must be taken in the upper division of the degree-granting CSU campus. A minimum of 45 units in GE including all of Areas A and B4 with grades of C or better in each course must be completed prior to transfer. Students must request certification at the time of transfer.
