- ❖ **Temporary Process to Streamline Certificates of Achievement:** At the October 30th meeting, CCC approved a temporary process to streamline local approval of existing non-transcriptable certificates and low unit certificates of achievement, to be modified into certificates of achievement. - ❖ **“Placement” Language on CORs:** As part of the ongoing work across campus to address AB 705, at the October 30th meeting CCC approved new language to replace references to “placement” in the prerequisite, corequisite, and Advisory statements on course outlines of record. Such language will be replaced with “equivalent” (e.g., “Completion of MATH 105 or equivalent”). The proposed timeline for implementing this new language is winter 2019 quarter, and Mary will be taking care of any necessary COR updates. Moving forward, please make sure to use this new language, wherever applicable, on your CORs. If you have any questions, please contact your Curriculum Reps.
