- ❖ **Program Deactivation:** On May 21st, CCC approved the deactivation of the Mathematical Foundations Certificate of Completion (noncredit), effective 2019-20.

- ❖ **Update to Department/Subject Name:** The BSS division has approved a change to the department name and subject name for GIST. The new name is Geospatial Technology and Data Science, effective 2019-20. The subject code used for courses will remain GIST.

- ❖ **Credit by Exam Petition Form:** At the May 21st meeting, CCC held a first read of a draft form for students to submit when requesting to use Credit by Exam for a course. The discussion focused on the process for submission of the form, what pieces of information should be requested of students, and how to best advise students on the implications of attempting Credit by Exam and receiving a grade via the Credit by Exam process (whether passing or failing). - ❖ **Credit for Prior Learning:** At the May 21st meeting, CCC began discussions regarding the topic of Credit for Prior Learning. Although Foothill already has local policies established to award credit for certain types of prior learning (AP, CLEP, IB), the state is moving to expand Credit for Prior Learning, in general. The goal of CCC's discussions is for Foothill to be prepared to address any forthcoming policy established by the state on this topic. CCC will continue this discussion at the June 4th meeting, with special guest Dolores Davison, and we welcome your feedback! For further information, please contact your CCC Reps.
