- ❖ Equity in the COR: At the November 29th meeting, CCC discussed a rough draft of a document currently titled Guiding Principles for Equitable CORs. This document is the result of many meetings' worth of discussion, and its purpose is to assist faculty in applying an equity lens when creating or updating CORs.
