The meetings started at 8:00 a.m. Jeff was asked to give an update on what was being discussed in the college wide curriculum committee. He mentioned some new certificates that have been proposed. He also mentioned that De Anza wants to start coordinating with Foothill in regard curriculum and what is being written. That is up for further discussion. Jeff mentioned there is continued discussion about having in writing a discontinuation program process. He said the bulk of the discussion continues to be about the implementation of equity into all CORs. We discussed how to implement this as a division. There will be continued discussion about on this subject.

Katy then discussed new curriculum and if any of us had ideas. Setsuka mentioned certifications for yoga and/or Pilates instructor. There was discussion on the feasibility due to the length of hours required to become a certified instructor. At this point, it doesn't seem feasible. We discussed other ideas.
