Before you apply

1. Visit the Diagnostic Medical Sonography website and read all available information.

2. Obtain a Campus Wide Identification Number (CWID) to apply for the Diagnostic Medical Sonography Program. You can get a CWID at no cost by applying to Foothill College. For full details, please check Foothill College's Registration Website.

Application Requirements

- 3. **Confirm Eligibility:** Review the program prerequisites and sample application to ensure you are ready and eligible.

- 4. **Calculate GPA:** Use the online tool to calculate your cumulative GPA: https://foothill.edu/counseling/gpacalc.html
- 5. **Gather Documents:** Obtain and prepare copies of the required documents.
 - Required Documents:
 - Official Electronic Transcripts (e-transcripts) from ALL colleges attended, except for Foothill and De Anza Colleges.
 - Completed and signed Patient Care Experience Form (DPCE).
 - Additional Documents: The following documents are optional. Please include them only if they are applicable.
 - o A copy of your American Heart Association BLS (CPR) Card
 - Copy of a completed General Education (GE) Pattern: Cal-GETC,
 CSU, IGETC, or Local Foothill College GE.
 - Copy of Degree Works that shows completed GE requirements

Transcripts

Returning applicants do not need to resubmit official transcripts unless they have completed new coursework that will affect their cumulative GPA.

Official Foothill College and/or De Anza College transcripts are not required. If you have prerequisite coursework completed from Foothill College or De Anza College, you must enter the coursework where appropriate on the application. We can verify your successful completion of that coursework internally.

Official college transcripts are required from *all* colleges you attended. Request transcripts from the Registrar or Registration office at each institution. Transcripts must be sent directly to Foothill College Admissions and Records via Official Electronic Transcripts (etranscripts).

If you hold an Associate's Degree from a California Community College or a Bachelor's Degree from a UC or CSU, your General Education requirements are automatically waived.

If you are unable to obtain any of the required documents, you must provide a letter of explanation to be attached to your application.

Please review our Diagnostic Medical Sonography Sample Application. Since this sample closely mirrors the actual application, you can use it to see exactly what information you will need to submit when you apply. We encourage you to fill out the sample to prepare.

Scanning and Saving Required and Optional Documents

6. Before applying, create a dedicated folder on your computer for all required documents.

Important File Requirement: Each required section allows for only one file attachment. Therefore, if you have multiple items for one section, you must combine them into a single file (e.g., one PDF) for upload.




8. Log in to My Portal.

10. Click on the Allied Health Card.




11. Click on the Apply button






12. Fill out and submit your application. Note that your progress will be saved automatically until the deadline. After you begin, we'll send you a confirmation email to the address listed on your application.
