Re: Formation of Study Group Focused on developing a definition and value statement for Service Leadership

At its December 11, 2020 C&C Council Meeting, the Community and Communication Council agreed to form a study group focused on developing a definition and value statement for Service Leadership.

1. Overall Purpose

- a. Form a study group that will report back to C&C with a recommendation that will then be discussed and voted on by the full council
- b. Ends June 2021, or earlier if the charge is completed

2. Charge of the Study Group

- a. Collect examples of Service Leadership already occurring across campus to better understand the diversity of projects and approaches already in use
- b. Draft a detailed and nuanced definition for Foothill's Service Leadership that includes a value statement, reflects a college philosophy, and anchors the work in Equity Plan 2.0
- c. Draft a 2-year plan for next steps for Service Leadership, including opportunities for public input (town halls? Brown bags?) and retrospective after the Research Symposium

3. Overall Composition

- a. Two classified staff appointed by Classified Senate
- b. One full-time and one part-time faculty appointed by Academic Senate
- c. Two students appointed by ASFC
- d. One administrator selected by C&C
- 4. Expertise Needed (to target recruitment)
 - a. Student perspective
 - b. Experience with Research and Service Leadership Symposium
 - c. Experience with other aspects of Service Learning/Service Leadership at Foothill

5. Time commitment / timeline

- a. Study Group to be assembled by March 19, 2021
- b. Group will most likely need to meet every other week for 60-90 minutes to discuss data gathered and draft recommendations. Group will determine time and frequency of meetings.
 - i. Draft definition/value statement due to C&C council by April 23, 2021
 - ii. Draft plan due to C&C by June 1, 2021

6. Responsibilities of members

- a. As the Study Group decides, reach out to constituents to solicit information on existing Service Leadership activities and gather input that will help shape Foothill's definition and value statement/college philosophy. Take notes to bring back to the study group.
- b. Report back to the C&C council.
- c. Work with colleagues to draft definition/value statement/college philosophy.
- d. Work with colleagues to draft 1-2 year plan.
