The college is responsible for making everything accessible.

We brainstormed ideas for getting faculty onboard for accessibility:

- Making it easy to get support.
- Make a webpage, send out messaging with a link to Poptech
- Other ideas: use the J1, get the deans trained and on board, consistent messaging from all admin, use more stick than carrot, and have a student voice focus. Simplify the message “Here’s how to check your accessibility.” Create an opening day event.
- **How will deans support accessibility online if they haven’t taught?**

Hybrid practices –34 faculty took an informal survey. We created an inventory of effective practices. Allison summarized results of the survey in a slide deck.

- Amy shared that the faculty in Fine Arts were responsive, and they had a lot of ideas for engaging students.
- In HSH the skills lab is hands on; the hybrid helps with productivity. Information sharing in the live session.
- When only one unit is online, asynchronous discussion or assessment is used.
- The asynchronous portion keeps the connection with students. We need to rethink the way we present material. It takes more time to give online feedback that is helpful.
- Support and tools are needed like Hypothesis, Pronto, Harmonize, Whiteboard in Zoom,
- Is there parity of workload for students and faculty—the faculty should understand the time commitment for transforming an in person or fully online class into hybrid.
- The rigor should be the same regardless of the modality.
- Faculty need support and training in clear course design, online tools like Hypothesis, Harmonize, Pronto, Padlet, etc.
- Ashley—student perspective—it makes a difference if a faculty member is prepared and organized.

Follow up with Student Services.

- There’s a gap between reality and what is being presented. We are asking for quantitative data to report.
