### 1) Meeting Minutes

• The committee voted and approved the meeting minutes by consensus.

## 2) Withdrawal Grades Model Discussion

- Doreen presented the new withdraw grades:
  - FW: Faculty Withdraw
  - o MW: Military Withdraw
  - EW: Emergency Withdraw
- The discussion questions were as follows:
  - How should the new grades be reported in Foothill's model?
  - How should we come to consensus as a district about how to treat these new grades in program review?
- There was some discussion on whether FW, MW, and EW should be graded as a type of Non-Success or as a Withdrawal.
- The committee discussed a few considerations:

- The reasons for using an FW should be identified.
- Success and Non-Success indicate factors that are within faculty control, but FW, NW, and EW may not be within faculty control.
- The committee will take this discussion to Academic Senate, Academic Professional Matters, and Equity and Education for feedback and will report back to IP&B.

## 3) Admissions & Records Student Success Template

- Laurie and Anthony presented the A&R template.
- The committee reviewed the template and made edits.
- There was a request to include data trends for the following areas:
  - Completion of CCC Apply

  - $\circ \ \ \, \text{Completion of education plan}$
  - Register for classes
- There was an additional discussion to include data trends and questions related to:
  - The service areas of A&R (i.e., cashiering, drop for non-payment, holds)
  - Gender breakdown
  - Comparison to college data (if applicable)
- The A&R template will be revised and reviewed at the next IP&B Meeting on January 28th.
