

### Foothill 2030 Timeline

Part of the college planning cycle involving a regular review of the mission statement, vision statement, and the educational master plan

#### Fall 2023

Form Foothill 2030 effort Identify

- Vision statement group
- Ed Master Plan group

**Approve** Revised college mission statement

**Submit** mission statement for Board approval

- Vision statement
- Planning documents Identify alignment with Vision 2030



#### Spring 2024

**Draft** Ed Master Plan Approve revised vision statement

**Collect** focus group perspectives **Review** existing data and metrics



Summer 2024

#### Fall 2024

**Draft** Ed Master Plan **Solicit** campus feedback



Winter 2025

**Submit** Ed Master Plan for Board approval
