# First two sentences of draft statement...

- It is easily understood.
  - Strongly agree: 32%; Agree: 54%
- It is inspiring.
  - Strongly agree: 28%; Agree: 47%
- It captures what the college does.
  - Strongly agree: 27%; Agree: 59%
- It describes who we serve.
  - Strongly agree: 23% ; Agree: 48%
- It identifies what makes Foothill unique
  - Strongly agree: 16%; Agree: 42%
