- PRC commends the department on its excellent course and program success rates, completion rates
- PRC commends the department on its incredible efforts to launch the baccalaureate degree.
- PRC commends the department for its successful implementation of completion degree – will help both enrollment and productivity

**SUGGESTIONS FOR IMPROVEMENT:**

- PRC suggests that the department continue to monitor and strategize about the effectiveness of the certificate.
- PRC expressed concern about low productivity and suggests that the department explore the possibility of capturing some of the students left in applicant pool.
- PRC recommends that the department monitor enrollments, and success of Latinx students in the program as there appears to be disproportionate impact.
