2019-20 Transfer Fair and Transfer Celebration Student Demographics RE:

Overview

The Transfer Center provided Institutional Research & Planning (IR&P) with a list of students IDs who attended the transfer fair and transfer celebrations. IR&P was asked to report on their gender and ethnicity. While data is provided for the past 4 years as well as for the most recent fall 2020 term (transfer fair only), the 2019-20 data is the primary focus of this report.

Number of Participants

- Transfer Fair: In 2019-20, the number of students who participated in the fall quarter transfer fair totaled 341 students, a decrease of 19% from the prior year. More recently, 164 students attended the fair in fall 2020, which was held in a virtual environment due to COVID-19 restrictions.
- Transfer Celebration: In 2019-20, 88 students attended the end-of-year transfer celebration. The event had 37 fewer participants from a year ago, a decrease of 30%. The June 2020 celebration was held virtually due to COVID-19.

Gender

- Transfer Fair: Female and male students were just as likely to participate in the 2019-20 transfer fair. In fall 2020, the fair had more female participants (55%).
- Transfer Celebration: As in the years prior, more females participated in the 2019-20 transfer celebration than males, 64% and 36% respectively.

Ethnicity

- Transfer Fair: Asians continue to be the largest ethnic group to attend the transfer fair. In 2019-20, Asians accounted for 39% of all participants. Latinx and White students each comprise about 24% of the attendees. More recently in fall 2020, the transfer fair saw an increase in the proportion of African Americans participants (17%) compared to the prior years.
- Transfer Celebration: Nearly two-thirds of the June 2020 transfer celebration participants were Asian (33%) and Latinx (31%).
