Overview

Foothill College's Fall 2019 enrollment was 12,983. Table 1 shows the gender breakdown for that academic term, with female students composing the majority of student enrollment (55%).

Table 2 shows that the overwhelming majority of students are enrolled part-time, enrolling in fewer than 12 units (78%).
