

Students' vaccination status against COVID-19?




Are you currently vaccinated against COVID?

How likely will you be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 by September?



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


Student Preferences for Fall Classes?




Do you plan to enroll at Foothill College in the fall quarter?



If you were to enroll in fall classes, what format would you prefer?




Which students prefer fully on campus format?



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







N=1,431 | No scheduled mtgs: No required meting times. | Mixed format: Some class mtgs held in real time (via Zoom) but other mtgs and coursework can be completed independently. | Regularly scheduled mtgs: All class mtgs held in real time (via Zoom) and attendance is required.




Which activities are "very important" to do on campus regardless of instructional modality?

- Students prefer online classes
 - Not in local area
 - Work and home demands
 - Transportation (time and cost)
 - Health concerns
 - Flexibility



COVID-19 Perspectives

- Some students will not be vaccinated
- Some students have concerns
 - Herd immunity
 - Variants/Vaccine efficacy
 - Health issues
 - Discrimination



Summary

- Students seek flexibility regardless of modality
 - Flexible attendance rules for illness
 - Transparent rules for missing classes
 - Flexible make-up options for missed classes
