RE: FHDA F1 Headcount Trend, 2016-17 to 2020-21

Overview

Students who enrolled at either Foothill College or De Anza College with the F1 visa status were identified to report a five-year trend. Table 1 shows the F1 visa headcount by college for each of the past five academic years. In this time period, Foothill's proportion of F1 visa students decreased from 37% in 2016-17 to 30% in 2020-21.

Table 2 shows the percentage change by college among F1 visa headcount from 2016-17 to 2020-21. Foothill experienced a larger percentage rate decrease compared to De Anza (+16%), with a decline of over half of its F1 visa students from 2016-17. Overall, the total F1 visa students decreased in headcount by almost half compared to five years ago (-48%).
