## Before you apply:

1. Please visit the Pharmacy Technician website and read the available

2. In order to apply to the Pharmacy Technician Program, you must obtain a campus wide identification number or CWID. If you don't have a CWID, you may obtain one by submitting an application to Foothill College, at no cost to you. #### **Required Documents**: Please obtain copies of the following documents:

 Official Electronic Transcripts (e-transcripts) from ALL colleges attended, except for Foothill and De Anza Colleges. See *Transcript* instructions below.

<u>Additional Documents</u>: You are welcome to include the following documents, if they apply to you, or you would like to include them with your application.

- **Approved** petitions (required if applicable)
- Math Placement results
- Documentation of completion of CSU or IGETC General education
- BLS Card copy

### **Transcripts**

Due to the transition of our application system, if you are a previous applicant you must submit all new official electronic transcripts to Foothill College Admissions and Records.

Official Foothill College and/or De Anza College transcripts are not required. If you have prerequisite coursework completed from Foothill College or De Anza College you must enter the coursework where appropriate on the application. We can verify your successful completion of that coursework internally.

You should obtain your College Transcripts by requesting a copy from all the Colleges you've attended. Typically, registrar offices or registration departments at the corresponding college will assist you with this. Please note that unofficial copies will not be accepted and may automatically disqualify you. You must request that electronic transcripts or e-transcripts be sent to Foothill College Admissions and Records: <a href="mailto:fhtranscripts@fhda.edu">fhtranscripts@fhda.edu</a>. If your school doesn't offer this option, please mail them to:

Remember that if you received an Associate's Degree from a California Community College and/or Bachelor's degree from a UC or CSU, completion of your General Education requirements will be waived.

If you cannot obtain any of the required documents, please be prepared to provide a letter of explanation, which will be attached to your application.

## Scanning and Saving Required and Optional Documents

4. Please save the required documents (listed above) to the computer you intend to use, when applying. We recommend that you put together a file with all of these documents, so that they can be easily accessed while you're completing your application. Please note that you will only be allowed one file attachment for each required section. As a result, your college transcripts, for example, must all be uploaded as one file. 


5. When you are ready, begin your Pharmacy Technician program


6. Log into My Portal.

#### 7. Find the Allied Health icon and click on it




8. Find the Apply Here link.



9. Fill out and complete your Pharmacy Technician Application. Your application progress will be saved until the deadline, or until the program is filled – whichever comes first. You will receive an email after you've begun your application, to the email displayed on your application.



10. Attach all documents by clicking on the designated boxes. After you click, you will be asked to choose from your saved files to upload.



### Submit your application

11. When you are ready, submit your program application by signing it electronically.

You will not be able to do this until you have filled all of the required sections.

No changes will be allowed after you've signed the application.

Applicants may submit one Pharmacy Technician application per year.

12. You will be receiving an email confirming that you've successfully submitted your application, along with a copy of it, for your records. The email will be sent to the email linked to your MyPortal account, and displayed on the first page of the application.
