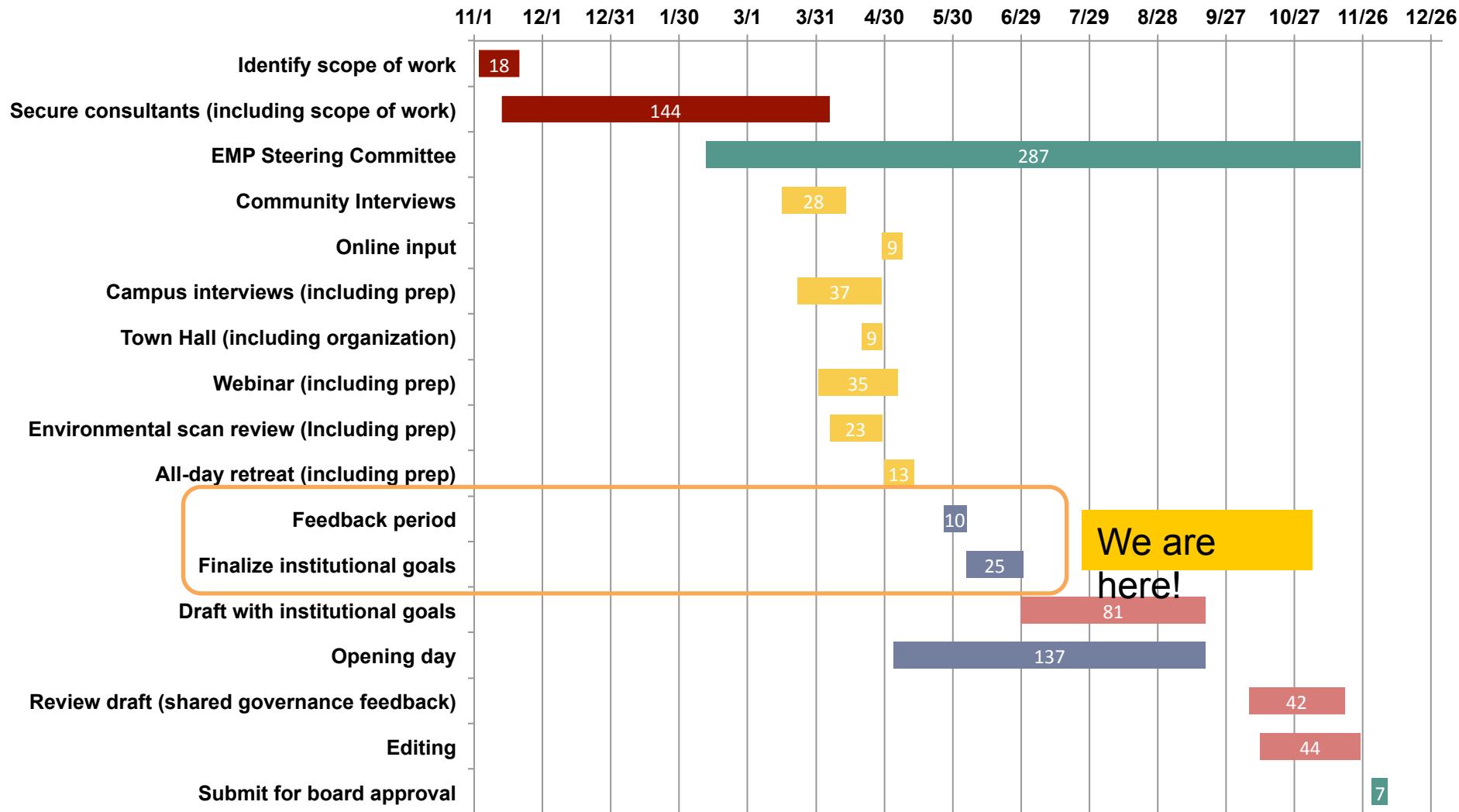

# EMP Overview

- Data collection and review (Spring 2015)
  - Part of data includes community and campus-level viewpoints and perspectives
- Discussion and dialogue (Spring 2015)
  - PaRC/EMP steering committed
  - Campus-level input (face-to-face, online, email)



# Educational Master Plan Timeline

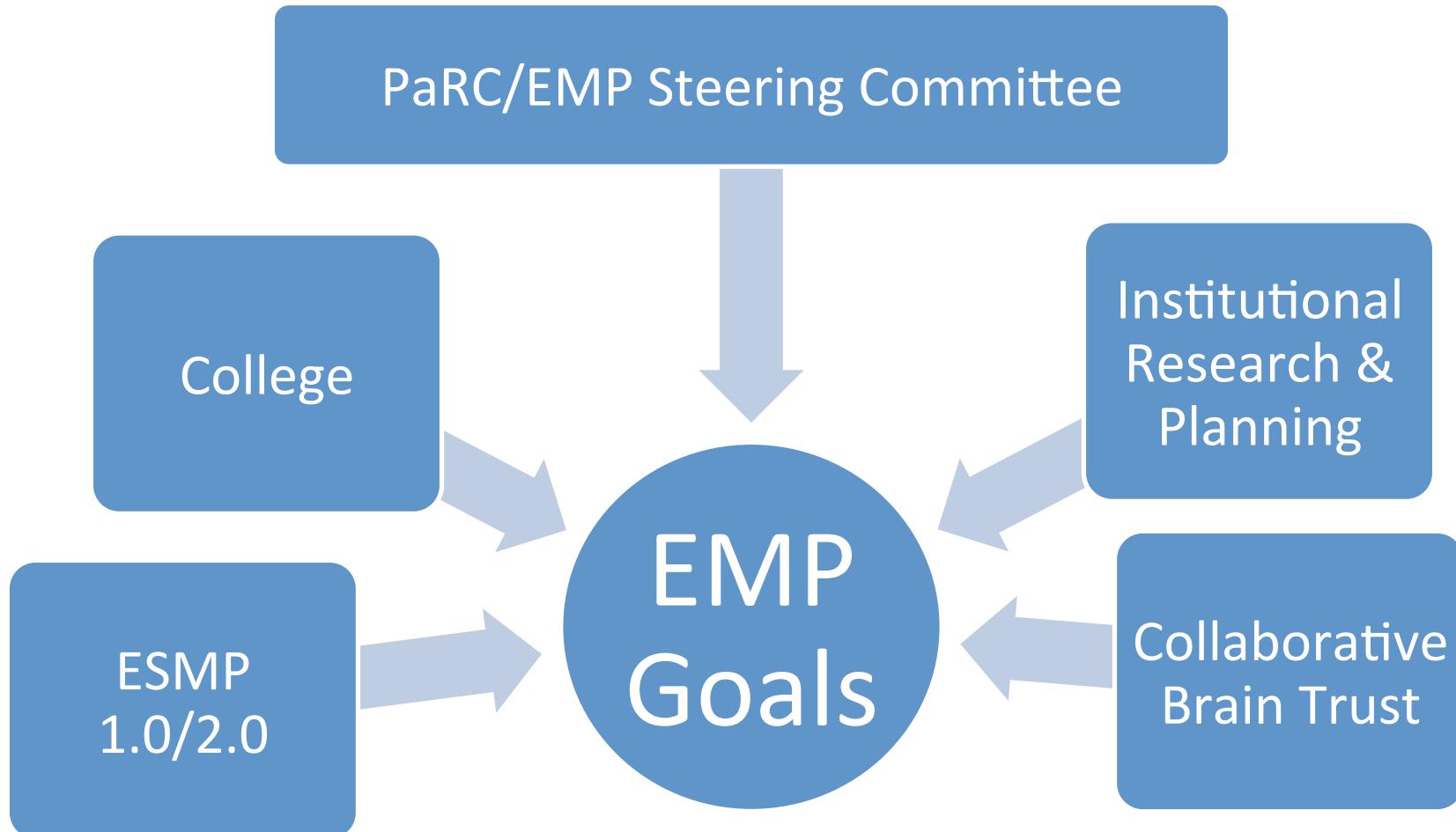

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# EMP: A Collaborative Process



# Division of Labor Part 1

## PaRC/EMP Steering Committee

- Review and discuss all data (meaning making)
- Identify college needs
- Recommend institutional goals

## College

- Provide feedback about institutional strengths, weaknesses, and areas for focus
- Engage in dialogue about institutional goals and area for focus over next 5-8 years
- Offer suggestions and comments regarding the EMP revise process and proposed draft institutional goals

## College President

- Provide leadership by ensuring shared governance process with the EMP revise



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# Division of Labor Part 2

## Institutional Research & Planning

- Identifies data related to environmental scan (internal and external)
- Focus on quantitative data but with analysis of qualitative data
- Facilitates discussion related to data (context and meaning)
- Organizes feedback opportunities for college (including online options)
- Promotes a transparent process by ensuring data and discussions are readily accessible

## Collaborative Brain Trust

- Conducted community and campus interviews
- Facilitated discussion at the EMP Steering Committee regarding quantitative and qualitative data findings
- Focused dialogue at the EMP Steering Committee to identify institutional goals



# Current Steps

- Spring 2015
  - Identify proposed draft institutional goals (5/13)
  - Opportunity for college feedback
  - PaRC/EMP steering committee to meet 6/10
    - Review feedback
    - Determine key goals from initial list
  - Additional opportunity for college feedback
  - Goals finalized
    - Discussed in IP&B (summer)/PaRC (fall)

- Collaboration/Partnerships
  - Collaborate with K-12, adult education, and four-year colleges in ways that serve students and society.
  - Partner with business and industry to prepare students for the workforce.
  - Increase lifelong learning opportunities for our community.

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# EMP Proposed Goals

- Employee Support
  - Provide better onboarding, support and professional development for all college employees.
  - Encourage employee participation in leadership and activities that engages them with the college and the community.
- Equity
  - Create a culture of equity that promotes student success and strong support for underserved students.

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# EMP Proposed Goals

- Funding
  - Increase advocacy at the state level, increase grants and private donations to secure stable and sustainable funding, and manage college resources strategically.
- Governance
  - Strengthen everyone's sense of community and commitment to the College's mission; expand participation from all constituencies in shared governance.
  - Promote consistent and clear communication in order to create a more informed, cohesive and engaged community.

- Innovation
  - Recognize and support a campus culture that values innovation and creative problem solving.
  - Employ a data-drive decision-making process.
- Leadership
  - Articulates a clear vision and priorities for the College.

- Student Success
  - Encourage student participation in leadership and activities outside the classroom that engages students with the college and the community.
  - Reduce barriers and facilitate students' ease of access across the District and region.
  - Enhance support for online quality and growth for instruction and student services.

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
