ITEM I - RATIFICATION OF BUDGET REDUCTIONS – MINER

Will use Fall quarter to discuss in detail what programs will be eliminated and instructional programs to be reviewed.

The Board was not going to act on budget until September.

The tentative budget action would be June 20th.

June 6th the Board approved retention of classified staff until July 2012 instead of December 2011.

September Board action will be adopted budget and will take into account ending balance for year-end.

We didn't build our budget based on tax extensions.

If we were to go deeper, we still have enough \$\$ because of stability fund and ending balances.

ACTION: voted unanimously to approve the May Revise Budget Reduction Proposal
