




The Science Learning Institute (SLI) embodies Foothill's vision to offer outstanding STEM education through focused efforts on:

- Collaborative partnerships




Objectives

- Impact Foothill, Bay Area, California, USA & World (in that order but not all at once)




SLI Evolution

 - March 28, 2012



- Unidentified Opportunities: \$2.25M
