Need some help on your own research?

Join the Foothill Science Learning Institute's Micro-internship program as a research mentor. You will propose an 11 week project related to your own research or work that a student can work on independently, with some guidance from you. Then you'll get matched with a Foothill College student, and they will work with you for the winter quarter (1/9 - 3/24/23).

This will involve a 3 - 4 hour per week commitment as a mentor. You have the option to receive an \$250 honorarium for your participation.

- Get matched with someone by early December.
- Attend a program training in early December.
