- ❖ **Curriculum Committee Structure and Function:** Our current configuration of the CCC was established in 1994 and as you've probably noticed, the requirements from the State have changed a bit, as has oversight of compliance. At this point, we must reevaluate whether our unique, division-level curriculum committee structure is serving us well, or if Foothill faculty, staff and administrators would be better able to carry out their curriculum roles and responsibilities if we returned to a central College Curriculum Committee. Reps will be facilitating conversations with division faculty to discuss various problems and potential solutions. Please take advantage of the opportunity to take part in the conversations when they arise! At our next CCC meeting we'll be discussing how to best accomplish all that's required of us going forward.
