## "WE NEED YOUR FEEDBACK!" ITEMS:

- ❖ **Requisite Content Review Procedures & Implementation:** Per Title 5 changes, we must establish a clear plan for implementing new requisites, and establish an ongoing procedure for requisite review. We must document how we identify courses that might need a pre/corequisite, use research to determine impact of new requisites, especially disproportionate impact. This process must directly involve faculty, this is your opportunity to help shape the plan as it's being developed. Your Curr Reps will be facilitating conversations in your divisions. Please discuss your ideas with them, and with your colleagues.
- ❖ **Curriculum Committee Structure and Function:** We are currently reevaluating our unique, division-level curriculum committee structure to determine how we can best manage our mandated curriculum responsibilities. Your CCC reps are facilitating conversations to discuss various problems and potential solutions, and your CCC team is developing updated training materials and resources.
