- ❖ The following courses received **Stand Alone** approval on Feb. 19th: MDIA 1, 2B, 5, 30, 31, 51, 52 and 81B.
- ❖ **Curriculum Changes for 2013-14:** The Office of Instruction provided reps with lists of curriculum changes that will occur with the next Catalog, beginning Summer 2013. Please collaborate with your reps to review the changes for anything that might affect your programs or requisites for courses in your departments.

REMINDERS:

- ❖ **FH General Education for 2013-14:** Your CCC reps received the draft list of all courses approved for inclusion in the Foothill GE pattern for the 2013-2014 Catalog. If you have a GE course, get the list from your rep and make sure your course(s) are on it! If a course seems like it's missing to you, contact your rep immediately, as the window of opportunity to correct errors is rapidly closing. If you'd like to add a new course to the GE pattern for next year, you must have applications approved by your division curriculum committee and to the Office of Instruction by **February 28th**.
- ❖ **2013-14 Curriculum Sheets:** The Curriculum Sheets (also referred to as the Program Sheets) are due to the Instruction Office on **March 1st**. Please remember that curriculum sheets are subject to approval by your division curriculum committees before they are moved forward.

- ❖ The CCC had a first read of a resolution that would impose a four-quarter-unit minimum on courses for inclusion in Areas I-VI of the Foothill GE pattern.
