- ❖ The following courses received **Stand Alone** approval on April 16th: NCEL 411, 412, 413, 421, 422, 423.
- ❖ **Music History & Literature Certificate of Achievement:** The CCC approved this certificate and it's on its way to the FHDA Board of Trustees for approval at their May 13th meeting. Thanks to Elizabeth Barkley and Robert Hartwell for their hard work!
- ❖ **IGETC/CSU GE Certification list:** Bernie Day has the results of our proposals for new courses to be included on the list (you should have received it by email last week). Three primary reasons caused denials: too narrow/technical to meet broad-based intent of GE; did not meet scope/intent of the particular GE area, and science courses don't clearly outline how scientific method is employed.
- ❖ **New Need/Justification Guide:** There is a new guide explaining the purpose of the Need/Justification statements for courses, and provides examples and guidance for writing them. It's attached, please take a look.
