- ❖ The following course was approved on May 21st for **Foothill GE for 2013-14:**

- ❖ The following course received **Stand Alone** approval on May 21st: GERN 54
- ❖ **UC Transferability for 2013-14:** The deadline to submit new courses and major changes for UC transferability for the 2013-14 year is June 1st. Please contact Bernie Day if you have a new course in the works.
- ❖ **ACTION ITEM: Certificate of Achievement Descriptions.** The CCC has resolved that effective beginning the 2014-15 Catalog, each Certificate of Achievement must include a distinct description to include, at minimum, a statement identifying the intended student audience and the intended outcomes and value of certificate completion. Descriptions must be submitted no later than the deadline for the next printed catalog: March 1, 2014. However, faculty are encouraged to draft their certificate descriptions ASAP as they may be added to the online catalog. Examples of descriptions will be provided to your curriculum reps at the next CCC meeting.

REMINDERS:

- ❖ **Deadline for New courses for the 2014-15 Catalog:** All new courses must be in "Review" status by June 31, 2013.

"WE NEED YOUR FEEDBACK!" ITEMS:

- ❖ **Units in Residence:** Title 5 requires students to complete at least 18 units at Foothill to receive a Foothill AA/AS degree, but there is no minimum requirement for the number of units in courses for the major, specifically. It's currently possible for a student to earn a degree by completing any 18 units at Foothill even without taking any courses in their major. However, discipline faculty may choose to impose a minimum number of units or courses in the major provided this requirement is explicitly indicated on the curriculum sheet. There are many pros and cons to consider and your curriculum reps will facilitate discussions should you wish to explore adding such requirements.
