NEWS & ANNOUNCEMENTS:

- ❖ **New Local Degree and Certificates:** CCC has reviewed and approved a new AS degree and three Certificates of Achievement in *Geographic Information Systems Technology*. The three certificates offer students a stepped progression from one certificate to the next and then on to an AS degree. This progression provides a solid technical background in these information system concepts and applications that assist to gain necessary skills to progress to advance in their careers and prepare them for professional certification. They are on the FHDA Board agenda for approval at their June 16th meeting and with approval, they will be forwarded to the State Chancellor's Office for final approval. Congratulations to Allison Lenkeit Meezan and the Business and Social Science Division.
- ❖ **Associate Degree for Transfer (ADT):** CCC approved the following ADT applications at the June 3rd meeting and they have been sent to the FHDA Board of Trustees for approval at their June 16th meeting: Communication Studies (AA-T), Early Childhood Education (AS-T), Economics (AA-T), Political Science (AA-T), Spanish (AA-T) and Theatre Arts (AA-T).
- ❖ **ADT Progress:** Based on the requirements set by SB 1440, we certified with the State Chancellor's Office, that we would complete 17 ADTs by June 2014. Including the applications that are on our Board's agenda for June 16th, we will have completed the original 17 and 3 additional ADT disciplines added after our required certification dated January 2013. Congratulations everyone!!! Great job!

- ❖ **Lecture and Laboratory Activity Types:** Remember that all new courses must use lecture or laboratory activity types as "lecture-lab" is no longer an option. The definitions of lecture and lab activities are available through your curriculum rep or FA rep. Along with the change in activity type, load may change in some departments and those changes will occur in Fall quarter. Changes to courses to remove lecture-lab activities should be completed by the Fall curriculum deadline (December 5th). Please remember to check with Articulation and/or Instruction to make sure the changes are not going to disrupt the transferability or articulation of your course(s).
