Actions taken:

Anthro 22 - Approved addition to COR content

Anthro 51 - Conditional approval of textbook update. Sam and/or Kathryn – several of the books cited are more than 5 years old – this is ok but we should add a statement explaining there is no “recent” edition of the text in question or provide some other rationale for using older textbooks.

ANTH 67C, 67D, 67E – Approved however these courses will not be sent forward to the FHCCC until Kimberly Messina returns to campus – so perhaps they will be submitted for the 10/21 FHCCC meeting. The reason to wait is that these are “specialty” courses designed for study abroad purposes and there has been some debate about the wisdom/need for such courses. Kimberly is integral to this discussion.

ANTH13L – We will send this forward to have Cori deal with the lecture/lab conversion.

ANTH 8L, 8LX, 8LY – are being returned to the Anthro department in order for you to more completely differentiate the course content of these 3 courses. Perhaps you want to include the descriptions you provided in the Etudes site? Also, please check with Cori to see if there are repeatability issues.

SOC 4 & 5 are being pulled by Patricia Gibbs until the Global Studies TMC and relevant course CIDs are defined in order to hopefully get them more quickly through the state.

Aaron Greene may serve as a faculty member that “takes on” the Apprenticeship oversight. He has expressed interest and will be meeting with Kurt, Jon Rubin, Cori and others soon to try to work something out. We are hoping to get 25 APPR Title V updates through at our next meeting ...with more to follow. This is somewhat a function of how quickly Aaron can get up to speed on the curriculum needs.
