	ARCC Improvement Rate for Credit Basic Skills (Rate at which students move through a sequence)	By 2015, Foothill will achieve 67.0% or the highest score within the peer group <sup>2</sup> .
Improve student outcomes and close the achievement gap	Success rate of historically underserved student groups (Annual Course Success Rates by Ethnicity)	By 2015, Foothill will increase student course success by 5 percentage points, focusing on narrowing the gap among groups.
