Overview

Please find in this memo some highlights regarding the F1 students enrolled at Foothill during the 2011 Spring quarter:

- F1 international students is up 14% at 888 in Spring 2011 compared to 777 students in Spring 2010.
- Gender distribution and registration status in Spring 2011 are consistent with Spring 2010, with a 50/50 female and male population and a 92% full-time/8% part-time distribution for student status.
- F1 international students attempting 19 or more credit hours in Spring 2011 is 31% or 277 students, compared to 26% or 202 students in Spring 2010.

<u>Notes</u>

Home institution was determined by the campus where the majority of a student's credit hours were attempted.
