#### Overview

Students who enrolled in Non-Credit Parenting (NCP) courses in 2012 were identified to determine how many NCP courses they enrolled in and whether they enrolled in for credit courses. Table 1 shows that 761 students enrolled in a NCP course and about half of these students enrolled in at least two NCP courses during 2012 (51%). Only 1% of the students enrolled in NCP courses also enrolled in for credit courses during the same time period.

All NCP courses (400-403) were offered in Spring 2012 but only NCP 400 and NCP 402 were offered in Fall 2012 (Table 2). Almost half of all NCP enrollment in 2012 was in NCP 400 (45%), followed by NCP 402 (25%) and NCP 403 (17%). NCP enrollment at the section level can be found in Appendix 1.

Table 3 expands on the data presented in Table 1 to show that one-third of students enrolled in NCP enrolled in two NCP courses while one-fifth enrolled in three or more NCP courses during 2012 (Table 3).

The for credit courses taken by the eight NCP students span 18 departments, making up a total enrollment of 39 during one calendar year (Table 4). Almost one-fifth of the enrollment was in MATH (18%) with almost another one-quarter in CHEM and ESLL (23%).

Overall course success rates among for credit courses taken by NCP students indicate they are successfully passing the majority of these courses (82%) (Table 5). The nonsuccess rate is primarily from Math and Chemistry courses (MATH 105, MATH 234, CHEM 30A, CHEM 30B and ESLL 236). The course withdraws are attributed to CNSL 50 and MATH 1A.
