Middlefield Enrollment for ESLL, Basic Skills Math, Basic Skills English RE:

Overview

Middlefield campus course enrollment in ESLL, basic skills Math pathway and basic skills English pathway were identified to determine the number of students taking these courses between Fall 2012 and Winter 2014. Table 1 shows the ESLL course enrollment during this time period, indicating that only two courses were offered in the past year and a half on the Middlefield campus.

Courses in the basic skills Math pathway were offered every quarter at Middlefield with enrollment numbers ranging from 338 (F13: Math 220) to 12 (W14: Math 217) (Table 2). Math 220 was consistently offered at Middlefield between Fall 2012 and Winter 2014, while Math 230 and Math 235 was offered during the 2013 and 2014 academic years (excluding summer).

Table 3 reports the Middlefield campus course enrollment in ENGL 209 and ENGL 110, which compose the basic skills English pathway. It appears that ENGL 110 was offered during the academic year while ENGL 209 was offered every other quarter. The enrollment in both courses is typically in the mid-20s, with the primary exception of ENGL 110 during Winter 2014 (47). Note that enrollment in ENGL 209 declined from a high of 25 in Fall 2012 to a low of 16 in Winter 2014.
