Overview

As part of the Accreditation self-study, course scheduling and sequencing is assessed to ensure reasonable time to degree and certificate completion. This report provides time to degree by examining students who earned a degree for the first time in academic year 2016 and their first enrollment term at Foothill. Time to degree is measured in months and converted to years, and data is disaggregated by ethnicity and gender. The same methodology was repeated for certificate completion.

Median Time to Degree and Certificate Completion

- Among first-time award recipients in AY2016, the median time to degree and certificate completion was 4.2 and 3.2 years, respectively.
- Students with an AA took nearly a year longer than those with an AS, 4.7 vs. 4.0 years.
- Students with an AA-T or AS-T took about 4.0 years to earn their degree.
- Compared to a traditional associate degree, associate degree for transfer recipients obtained their degree in less time:
 - 4.7 years for AA vs. 4.0 years for AA-T; difference of 0.7 year or 8.4 months
 - 4.0 years for AS vs. 3.8 years for AS-T; difference of 0.2 year or 2.4 months
- Students with a certificate 45-89 Qtr comprised the majority of certificate recipients (84%) and they took 3.2 years to obtain their certificate.

Median Time to Completion by Program

AA Completion by Program

- AA degree: General Studies Social Science accounted for the majority of AA degree recipients (46%) and students obtained this degree in 5.0 years.
- AA-T degree: Psychology for transfer accounted for the majority AA-T degree recipients (33%) and students obtained this degree in 4.2 years. Communication Studies for transfer followed behind (22%) and students obtained this degree in 4.0 years.

• AS degree: Primary Care Associate Program accounted for the majority of AS degree recipients (18%) and students obtained this degree in 2.2 years. Veterinary Technology followed behind (10%) and students obtained this degree in 4.3 years.

- Certificate 27-44 Qtr: 61% of certificate recipients are Dental Assisting students and they obtained this certificate in 3.8 years.
- Certificate 45-89 Qtr: 80% of certificate recipients are Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC-UC) students and they obtained this certificate in 3.2 years.

Degree Completion

Degree Completion by Starting Academic Year

- 69% of students started between AY2011 and AY2016 and obtained a degree in 3.2 years.
- 20% of students started between AY2005 and AY2010 and obtained a degree in 7.8 years.
- 11% of students started in AY1999 or prior and took at least 14.5 years to earn a degree.
- The starting academic year for the 547 students who started between AY2011 and AY2016 was disaggregated even further, and the majority of these students completed a degree in 3.0 years.
 - 2010-11 to 2011-12: 167 students; 5.0 years
 - 2012-13 to 2013-14: 303 students; 3.0 years
 - 2014-15 to 2015-16: 77 students; 1.8 years

Degree Completion by Ethnicity, Starting AY2011-16

Since the majority of degree recipients enrolled at Foothill starting in AY2011-16, this section of the report examines their time to degree completion by ethnicity.

AA degree

- Most recipients self-identified as White (36%) and Latino/a (23%).
- The median time to an AA degree completion was 3.8 years.
- Latino/a and White students took longer to earn an AA degree, 4.1 and 4.0 years, respectively.

AA-T degree

- Most recipients self-identified as White (29%) and Latino/a (26%).
- The median time to an AA-T degree completion was 3.2 years.
- White students took 4.0 years, or 9.6 months longer, to earn an AA-T degree.

AS degree

- Most recipients self-identified as White (40%) and Asian (28%).
- The median time to an AS degree completion is 2.5 years.
- Latino/students comprised the third largest ethnic group of AS degree recipients at 18%, and they took 2.2 years, or 3.6 fewer months, to earn an AS degree.

AS-T degree

- Most recipients self-identified as White (31%) and Asian (31%).
- The median time to an AS-T degree completion was 3.2 years.
- White and Latino/a students each took 3.8 years, or 7.2 months longer, to earn an AS-T degree.

Certificate Completion

Certificate Completion by Starting Academic Year

- 82% of students started between AY2011 and AY2016 and obtained a certificate in 2.9 years.
- 14% of students started between AY2005 and AY2010 and obtained a certificate in 7.2 years.
- 4% of students started in AY1999 or prior and took at least 15.0 years to earn a certificate.
- The starting academic year for the 413 students who started between AY2011 and AY2016 was disaggregated even further, and the majority of these students completed a degree in 2.8 years.
 - 2010-11 to 2011-12: 105 students; 4.7 years
 - 2012-13 to 2013-14: 229 students; 2.8 years
 - 2014-15 to 2015-16: 79 students; 1.8 years

Certificate Completion by Ethnicity, Starting AY2011-16

Since the majority of certificate recipients enrolled at Foothill starting in AY2011-16, this section of the report examines their time to certificate completion by ethnicity. Only certificate 45-89 Qtr was examined as this certificate group comprised the majority of all certificate recipients.

- Most recipients self-identified as Asian (48%) and Other (22%).
- The median certificate completion was 3.0 years, and there was no difference in time to completion observed among the ethnic groups.
