Women's Volleyball Victory

Undefeated in Coast Conference South League, the Foothill College Women's Volleyball team

will take on Fresno City College for the NorCal Regional title and a trip to the State Championships! The game will take place on Tuesday, December 1 at 7 p.m. in the Foothill College gym. The Lady Owls finished the regular season with a 25-1 record, and number two ranking in the state. Earlier in the season, Riana Brennan was named the September 2015 Female Athlete of the month by the California Community College Athletic Association. Brennan, an All-American and All-State selection as a freshman, tallied 222 kills, 123 digs, 18 aces, and nine blocks across 42 sets. She averaged 5.3 kills and 2.9 digs per set on the month. Brennan is currently third in the entire CCCAA in kills per set and third in total kills.
