## Proof of English Proficiency for **International Applicants:**

International applicants are only exempt from this requirement if they are from a country whose official language is English or if they attend their entire high school career at a school whose instruction is conducted in English.

- IELTS: 6.5
- iTEP: 4.5
- SAT Critical Reasoning: 630
- ACT Reading: 28 AND English: 28
- TOEFL (iBT): 4.5, TOEFL (PBT): 575
- Pearson: 61
- *Satisfactory Duolingo interview result*

Applicants must complete at least 2/3 of the required coursework completed by the time of submission and admission is contingent upon satisfactory completion of any courses in progress.
