Learn how to build a competitive academic plan (calculus, lab sciences, writing, and humanities), choose courses that demonstrate readiness for upper-division work, and align your interests with research and honors opportunities you can pursue after transfer. We'll cover timelines and checklists, credit transfer realities, crafting evidencebased essays, selecting recommenders who can speak to your growth, and presenting leadership, work, and family responsibilities as strengths. You'll also hear how need-based aid works at Stanford, including scholarships, work-study, and special considerations for independent and first-gen students.
